

**FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEALS**

In accordance with law, the District shall provide free and reduced price meals for students whose families meet Federal eligibility criteria.

The Governing Board authorizes all certificated employees, school site secretaries, and appropriate technology personnel to use individual records pertaining to student eligibility for any free and reduced price meal program solely for the purpose of disaggregation of academic achievement data in accordance with Federal and State law and regulation.
